## WORDS FROM THE CEO

# Q U A R T Z I T E



Although many people often confuse it with granite, quartzite is a metamorphic rock like marble, rather than an igneous rock like granite. Extremely hard and compact, finer grained than granite, exotically-veined, colored like marble, and easy to maintain and keep bacteria-free, quartzite is the most versatile of all natural stones. Stronger than both marble and granite, quartzite holds the status of the most durable natural stone. In fact, quartzite can be considered nearly indestructible-resistant to chemical weathering, non-porous, scratch-resistant, and as hard as diamonds.

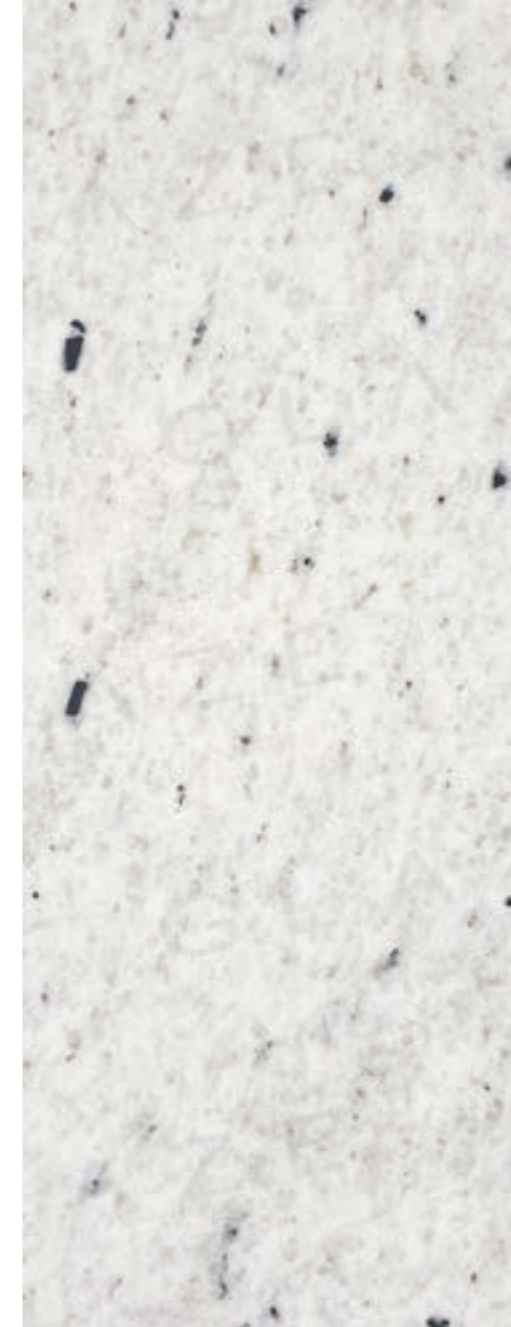




# GRANITE

Granite is a unique and special rock: the signature stone of planet Earth. While Mercury, Venus, and Mars are covered in basalt, only Earth has this attractive and interesting formation. The extreme strength of granite can be attributed to its density, which occurs due to the cooling of magma after a volcanic eruption. Quartz and feldspar found in granite make it harder than steel. Granite polishes beautifully and resists weathering, making it remarkably desirable for both building and ornamental purposes. This stone has been a favorite for kitchen countertops and flooring in both private and public spaces for decades.

Travertine is a form of massive calcium carbonate, a natural stone resulting from the sedimentation of rivers and springs. Although it's porous, it is remarkably dense and closely compacted form of limestone. It is the perfect material for residential and commercial use due to its subtle splendor and durability. The iconic Colosseum of Rome is an exquisite example of the architectural potential of travertine.

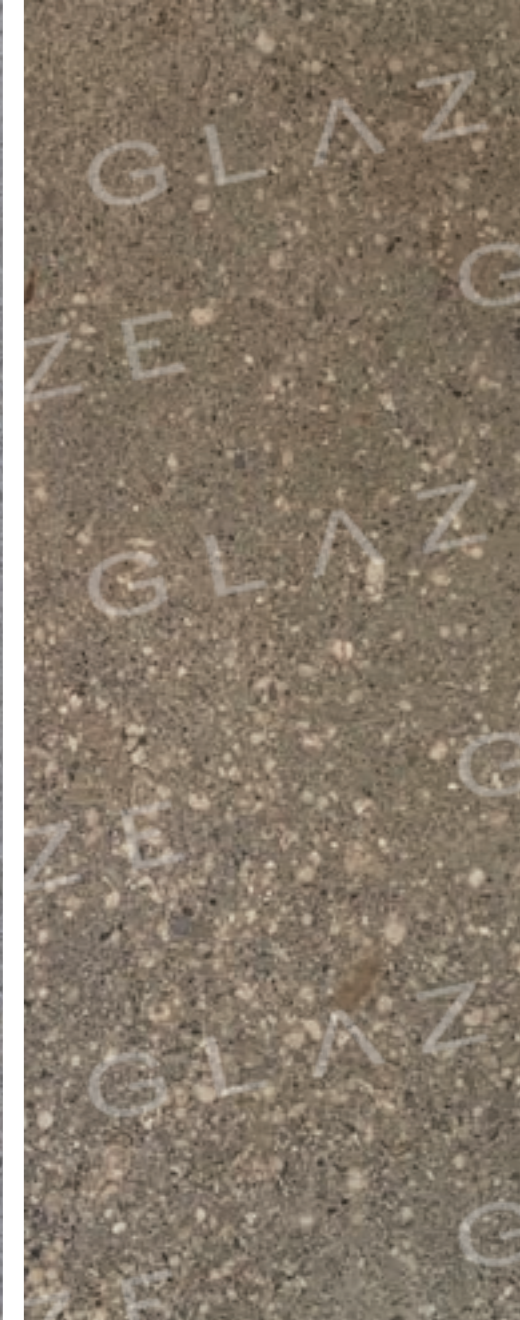
